<p>Score 1 – Very hard and dry; requires much effort to expel from body; no residue left on ground when picked up. Often expelled as individual pellets.</p>	<p>Score 2 – Firm, but not hard; should be possible, exaggerated appearance; little or no residue left on ground when picked up.</p>	<p>Score 3 – Log-like; little or no exaggeration visible; moist surface; leaves residue, but little form when picked up.</p>
		
<p>Score 4 – Very moist (soggy); distinct log shape visible; leaves residue and loose form when picked up.</p>	<p>Score 5 – Very moist but has distinct shape; present in piles rather than as distinct logs; leaves residue but loose form when picked up.</p>	<p>Score 6 – Has texture, but no defined shape; occurs as piles or as spots; leaves residue when picked up.</p>
	<p>Score 7 – Watery; no texture, the occurs as puddles.</p>
